





## CP'2018: Brief Recap


- \* Theme: Reaching out to related fields
  - Continued the track format: (Technical + 7)
  - \* Theme tracks are responsible for 50/114 submissions and 18/50 accepted papers
  - \* 3 Invited Talks
  - Five tutorials
    - \* How to model problems for solvers from various fields: MILP, NLP, MINLP, CP, SAT, SMT, etc.
- \* Outcome
  - \* 114 submissions, acceptance rate of 44% (Historical trends [105,137,107,114] & [51%,45%,43%,44%])
  - \* 3 outstanding papers accepted the invitation for a long version to *Constraints*
  - \* 156 attendees




# Organizing Committee
